By rail

International trains arrive in Lisbon every day, mainly to Santa Apolónia Station and more recently to the Oriente Station (Estação Oriente or Lisboa Oriente) - the newest railway station located in the former Expo Park, today known as Nations Park. Intercity trains connect all of Portugal's major cities to either Lisbon or Porto. Up-to-date information on local transportation, schedules and prices is available at www.cp.pt

By air - Lisbon airport

From the international airport, located 7 km north of the city, there are several options to continue your journey. Taxis are available from outside the terminal. Alternatively, you may wish to take the bus or the airport shuttle (Carris No. 96) available everyday, every 30 minutes between 7:30 a.m. and 10:00 p.m., connecting Oriente Station - Airport - Entrecampos - Sete Rios - Praça de Espanha.
